## DETAILS:

\*5 events testing all chess skill

\*open to all with USCF membership

\*prizes for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> in three rating divisions

\*Divisions are: under 1000, 1000- 1499; 1500 & up (all points are earned in the division you are in at the first event played)

\*based on cumulative points earned in all of the events (1= win ½ = draw)

\*each event will also have its own cash prize list

\*free score book to those who play in all 5 events

\* 1<sup>st</sup> place overall in TOP SECTION ONLY gets free entry into DE state championship

\* scholastic prizes donated by the Milford Chess Club: the top player from each of these grade divisions : Grades 1-6, and Grades 7-12, will receive free entry into the state scholastic championship
